# Your job

The purpose of this role:

# To support the creation of the 'Place for You Community Woodland' in Dee Park

You will work as part of a team working closely to support our Community Ranger and Community Outreach Officer. You will receive specialist training, including a suite of online and face to face accredited training to aid you in your role and progression.

Duties will include:

- Assisting with ground preparation for tree planting.
- Assisting with school and community tree planting events.
- Assisting with volunteer work parties.
- Assisting with thinning and coppicing in the mature woodland.
- Assisting with scrub clearance.
- Patrolling Dee Park on a regular basis, removing any litter and informally talking with park users and explaining about the work that is taking place.
- Assisting with survey work.
- Maintenance of the site and new planting through spring and summer.
- Assisting with the running of a large-scale celebration event at the end of the project.

## Qualifications and training

- Educated to NVQ Level 3 in a relevant discipline, or equivalent experience is desirable or be willing to learn relevant skills in the workplace.
- A passion for working in nature is essential.
- A driving licence is desirable but not essential.
